A Traditional Affirmation of Faith

*The Apostles' Creed in threefold question-and-answer form appeared
at least as early as the third century as a statement of faith used in
baptisms and has been widely used in baptisms ever since.*

*As we share this creed, we join with the universal church across the ages in
this historic affirmation of the Christian faith.*

Let us join together in professing the Christian faith
as contained in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments.

Do you believe in God the Father?

**I believe in God, the Father Almighty,
creator of heaven and earth.**

Do you believe in Jesus Christ?

**I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,
born of the Virgin Mary,
suffered under Pontius Pilate,
was crucified, died, and was buried;
he descended to the dead.
On the third day he rose again;
he ascended into heaven,
is seated at the right hand of the Father,
and will come again to judge the living and the dead.**

Do you believe in the Holy Spirit?

**I believe in the Holy Spirit,
the holy catholic church,
the communion of saints,
the forgiveness of sins,
the resurrection of the body,
and the life everlasting.**

Thanksgiving Over the Water

This prayer recalls scriptural images and meanings of Holy Baptism and is comparable to the Great Thanksgiving at Holy Communion.

The Lord be with you.

And also with you.

Let us pray.

Eternal God:

When nothing existed but chaos,
you swept across the dark waters
and brought forth light.

In the days of Noah

you saved those on the ark through water.

After the flood you set in the clouds a rainbow.

When you saw your people as slaves in Egypt,
you led them to freedom through the sea.

Their children you brought through the Jordan
to the land which you promised.

Sing to the Lord, all the earth.

Tell of God's mercy each day.

In the fullness of time you sent Jesus,
nurtured in the water of a womb.

He was baptized by John and anointed by your Spirit.

He called his disciples

to share in the baptism of his death and resurrection
and to make disciples of all nations.

**Declare Christ's works to the nations,
his glory among all the people.**

Pour out your Holy Spirit,

to bless this gift of water and she who receives it,
to wash away her sin

and clothe her in righteousness throughout her life,

that, dying and being raised with Christ,
she may share in his final victory.

**All praise to you, Almighty God,
through your Son Jesus Christ,
who with you and the Holy Spirit lives and reigns forever.
Amen.**

Baptism and Blessing

Ellasandra Gibbs, I baptize you in the name of the Father,
and of the Son,
and of the Holy Spirit;
Creator, Redeemer, and Sustainer. **Amen.**

(laying hands on the newly baptized)

The Holy Spirit works within you,
that being born through water and the Spirit,
you may be a faithful disciple of Jesus Christ. **Amen.**

(Anointing)

Ellasandra Gibbs, child of God, you are sealed by the Holy
Spirit in baptism and marked as Christ's own forever. **Amen.**

(Presentation of Baptismal Candle)

Ellasandra Gibbs, "Let your light so shine that others, seeing your
good works, may glorify your Father in heaven." **Amen.**
