Liturgy of Confirmation and Reaffirmation of Faith

Sisters and Brothers in Christ: Confirmation is a deeply important step in the faith journeys of these young persons before you. We celebrate together with them the culmination of many months of learning and reflection about God's love and grace. We learned what it means to be a follower of Jesus Christ. This is not the end of a journey. It is, instead, one important step on a lifelong journey. After baptism as infants, James, Eva, Frank and Katie, were nurtured in faith and love by their families and by fellow Christians. Today, these young persons profess their faith for themselves, reaffirming the vows of their baptisms. This is a sacramental act through which God works to further shape their lives and mold them into the loving persons they were created to become.

(The candidates stand before the congregation with their parents and mentors.)

RENUNCIATION OF SIN AND PROFESSION OF FAITH

- Pastor: I ask you now: Will you turn away from the powers of sin and death?
- *People:* We renounce the spiritual forces of wickedness, reject the evil powers of this world, and repent of our sin!
- Pastor: Will you let the Spirit use you as prophets to the powers that be?
- People: We accept the freedom and power God gives us to resist evil, injustice, and oppression in whatever forms they present themselves!
- Pastor: Will you proclaim the good news and live as disciples of Jesus Christ, his body on earth?
- People: We confess Jesus Christ as our Savior, put our whole trust in his grace, and promise to serve him as our Lord, in union with the church which Christ has opened to people of all ages, nations, and races!
- Pastor: Will you receive and profess the Christian faith as contained in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments?
- People: We affirm and teach the faith of the whole church as we put our trust in God, the Loving Parent, in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, and in the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.
- Pastor: Will you be living witnesses to the gospel, individually and together, wherever you are, and in all that you do?
- **People:** We will remain faithful members of Christ's holy church and serve as Christ's representatives in the world.
- Pastor: As members of this congregation of the United Methodist Church, will you commit yourselves to participate in its ministries and mission?
- People: Together, we are the body of Christ for the world. We commit to participate faithfully in the ministries of the church by our prayers, our presence, our gifts, our service, and our witness.
- Pastor: Will you nurture one another in living the Christian faith and life?
- People: With God's help, we will proclaim the good news and live according to the example of Christ. We will embody faith, hope, love, and forgiveness so that all of us may continue to grow in our trust in God and express our faith in action. We will pray for one another on our journey of discipleship together.
- Pastor: Will you strive to live in the way that Jesus laid out for his disciples?

People: We will strive to love God with all of our heart, soul, mind, and strength and to love our neighbors as ourselves. We will learn to love one another as Jesus loves us.

Pastor: Let us all say the Lord's Prayer

All: The Apostle's Creed

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended to heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty, and will come again to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the true Christian church of all times and all places, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

THANKSGIVING OVER THE WATER

Pastor: Truly, the Spirit of the Lord is in this place.

People: We rejoice that the Spirit of God is among us!

People: Your healing waters flow over us. Your Spirit embraces and inspires us. Spirit of fire, Spirit over the waters, Spirit of holiness! We praise you!

Pastor: Merciful God, pour out your Holy Spirit upon this gift of water. Let it be a vivid symbol and reminder of grace declared to us in our baptism. For you have washed away our sins and you clothe us with righteousness throughout our lives that, dying and rising with Christ, we may share in his final victory. We pray that you will strengthen and inspire these four young persons to live in ongoing loving relationship with you by the power of the Holy Spirit.

(Pastor Jane will call each confirmand forward with their family).

(James, Eva, Frank, Katie), You are a beloved child of God. Remember your baptism and be thankful. You have committed yourself to faithfully follow Jesus Christ and strive to live a holy life. May God's Spirit inspire and guide you. Amen.
