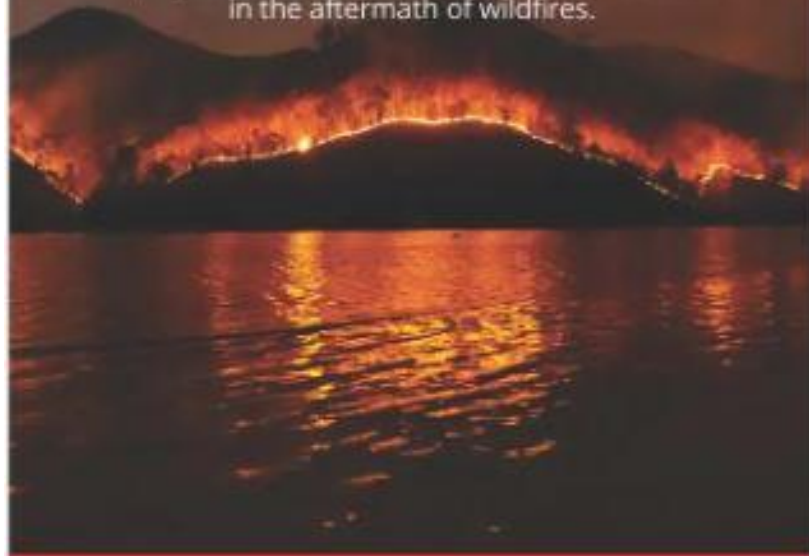

Please keep the donations coming so we can continue this very important ministry to feed our neighbors in need.

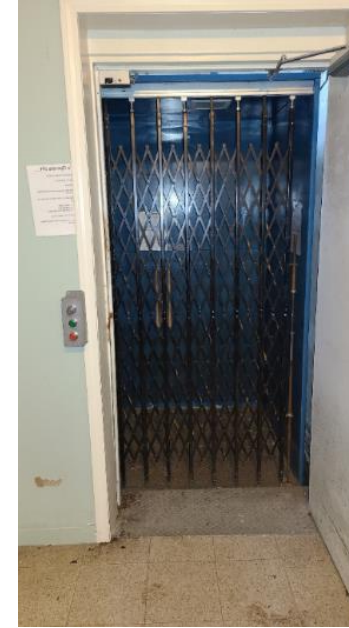


# CUMC's Annual **Rainbow** Food Drive Kicks-off September 25<sup>th</sup>!
