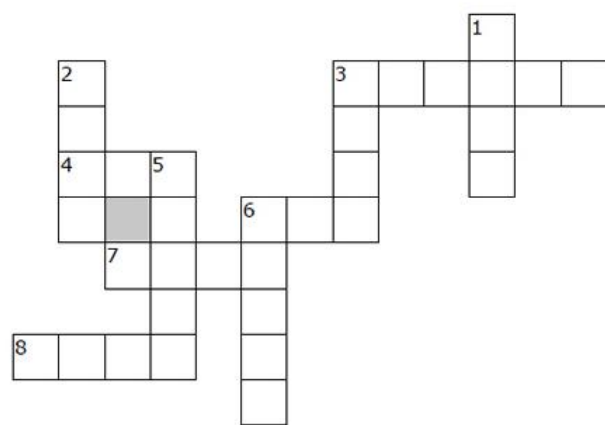
Jesus Teaches about Prayer
