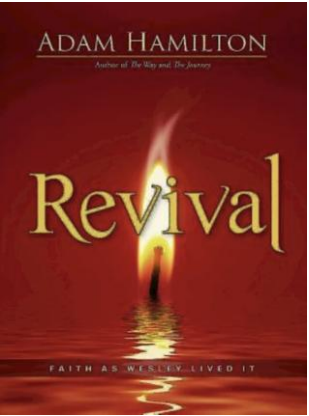
Monday Bible Study is Back!

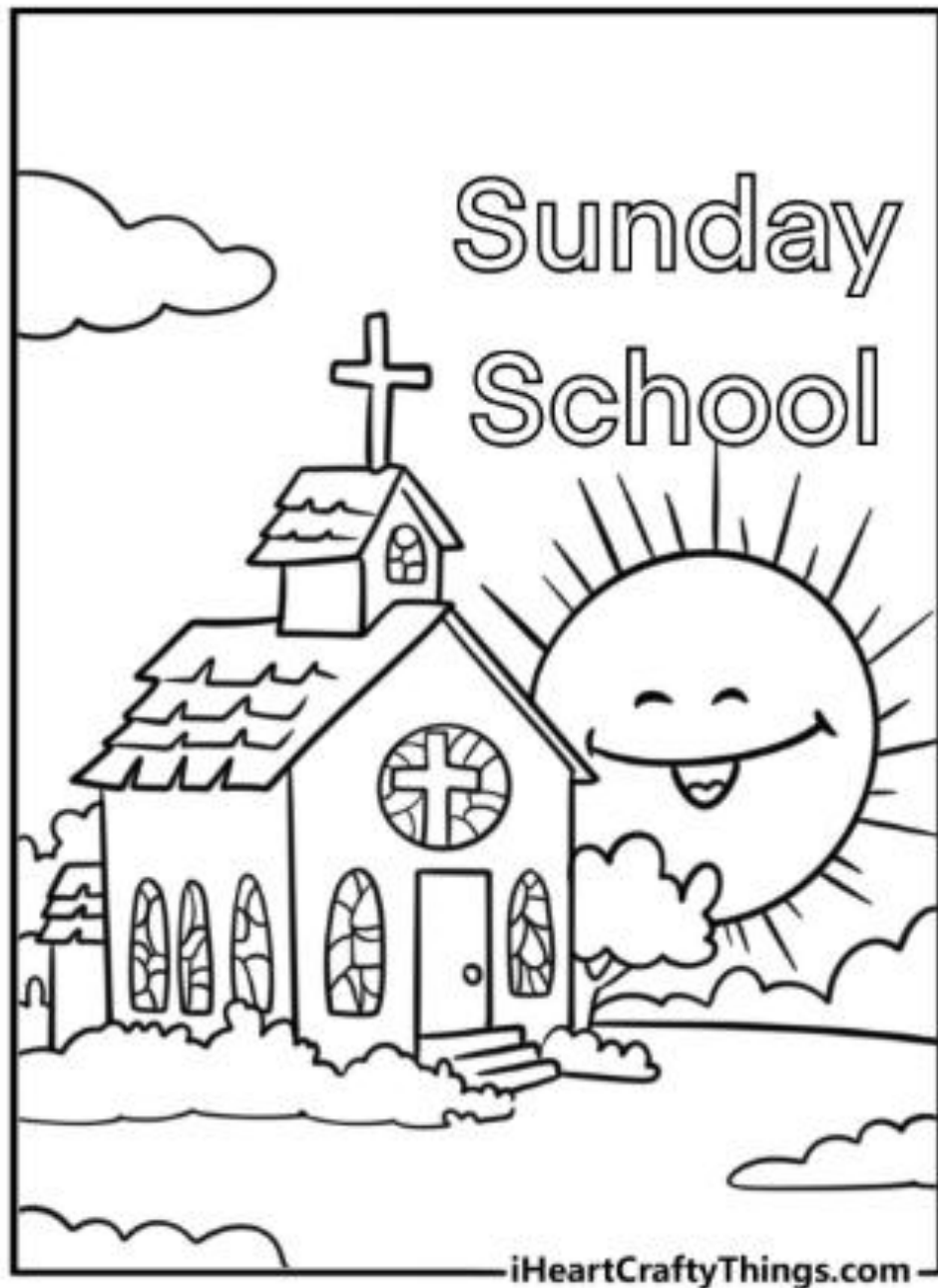
