In this five-week sermon series, we'll look at each aspect of this membership vow and how United Methodists can answer the call to serve Christ through the local church.

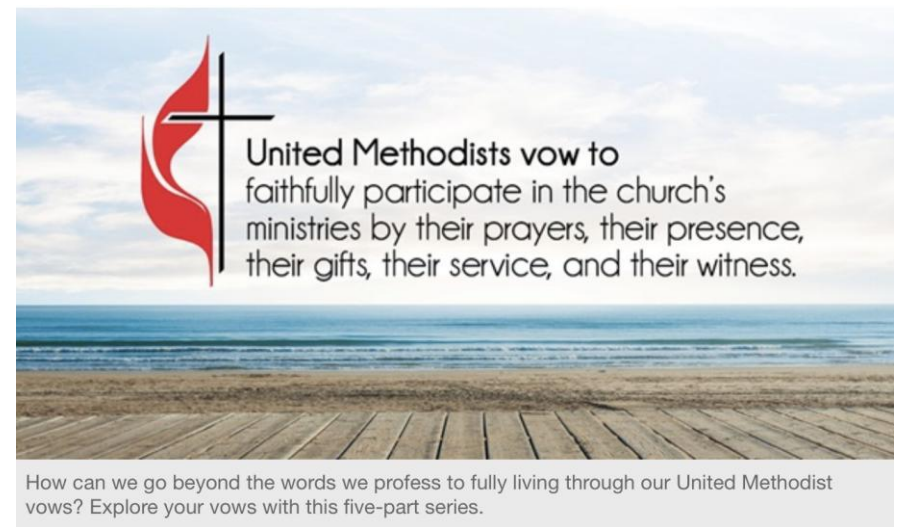
