Our Spring Capital Campaign is in full swing! The Trustees of CUMC have targeted 3 major projects that need to be addressed this spring: Church **Siding**, Parsonage **Patio**, Downstairs Church **Hallway**. Our goal is to raise \$25,000 total to manage the cost of these projects. The first \$10,000 will be allotted for the siding of the two exterior south side walls of the church. The second \$10,000 will go to the parsonage exterior repairs to the patio surround, needed window replacements and several other needed upgrades. The final \$5,000 will be used to install new flooring in the church basement hallway and replace a metal door at the end of the hallway. Please give generously. It is always a joy to work together as a family to serve God and “give back” to maintain our properties at CUMC.



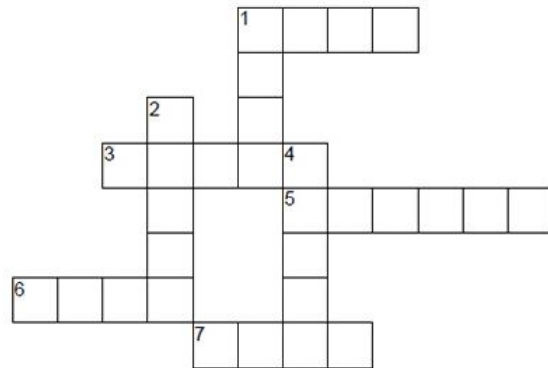
